1. Routine EEG, continuous video EEG, Epilepsy Monitor Unit (EMU) and pre-surgical workup for epilepsy surgery.
2. Electromyography (EMG) and Nerve Conduction Study (NCS).
3. Evoked Potential including Visual Evoked Potential (VEP), Somatosensory Evoked Potential (SSEP) and Brainstem Audio Evoked Potential (BAEP).
4. Vagal Nerve Stimulator (VNS) programming and management.
5. Botulinum toxin injection treatment for chronic headache, cervical dystonia and spasticity.
